

- Revenue and EBIT
 - Operating revenues increased by 17.6 percent to NOK 453.7 million (y-o-y)
 - EBIT increased by 51.5 percent to NOK 55.7 million (y-o-y)

- Strong market


Revenue and number of employees
MNOK and number





 - Represents 25.1 percent of total revenues in Q2'18

○ Power supply

- Increased by 27.0 percent (y-o-y)
 - Represents 10.0 percent of total revenues in Q2'18



○ Info and communication






Customer and project mix

- Project mix
 - Variable contracts account for 97.2 percent of total revenues
- Customer portfolio
 - The 10 largest customers represent 37.4 percent of total revenues – up from 34.8 percent in Q2'17
 - The 20 largest customers represent 49.6 percent of total revenues – up from 47.4 percent in Q2'17




Customer development

Revenue customer split







Deltakere fra IT-bedrifter i hele landet konkurrerte om å være Norges beste hacker i Paranoia Challenge 2018. Eivind fra Bouvet kom på tredje plass i finalen.

- Det var veldig overraskende for meg å komme så høyt opp på lista. Jeg har alltid vært interessert i cybersikkerhet og hacking og den slags. Men det har alltid vært litt vanskelig å vite hvor man skal begynne. Å komme så høyt opp på første forsøk hadde jeg aldri trodd, sier Eivind Andreas Arvesen som ved en tilfeldighet ble med på Paranoia Challenge 2018.

The Challenge

Paranoia Challenge 2018 er en konkurranser i cybersikkerhet. Der deltakere fra en rekke norske virksomheter, som til daglig jobber med IT eller sikkerhet, møtes til en uhøytidelig kamp som utfordret både kunnskaper og evne til å løse offensive og defensive oppgaver.

Vant pris for masteroppgave om treningspill

Jonas André Dalseth vant Norsk Regnesentrals pris for beste masteroppgave innen matematikk og IKT delt ut ved NTNU med oppgaven "Fitogotchi - An Exergame Designed to Change People's Everyday Physical Activity Habits".

Treningspill for gamere

Masteroppgaven «Fitogotchi - An Exergame Designed to Change People's Everyday Physical Activity Habits» gikk ut på å designe et spillkonsept som skulle motivere til fysisk aktivitet hos gamere. Målet var å se på hvordan et spill kan påvirke folks hverdagsaktivitet, og se på hvordan man kan motivere en gruppe mennesker til å bli mer fysisk aktive igjennom et spill.




Revenue

- Revenues increased by 17.6 percent y-o-y
 - Revenues from own consultants increased by 18.7 percent to NOK 377.9 million
 - Revenues from sub-contracted consultants increased by 10.8 percent to NOK 60.0 million
 - Other revenues increased by 19.9 percent to NOK 15.8 million




Revenues from own consultants

- Increased 18.7 percent y-o-y
 - Positive impact from increase in billing ratio by 0.7 percentage points
 - Positive impact from 11.2 percent increase in average number of employees
 - Positive impact from 3.5 percent increase in prices for group hourly services
 - 60 workdays in Q2'18 – two more than Q2'17


Revenue per employee (quarterly figures)




Revenue per employee (LTM)




Analysis of change in revenues y-o-y




Earnings

- Operating profit (EBIT) up by 51.5 percent to NOK 55.7 million
- EBIT margin of 12.3 percent compared to 9.5 percent in Q2'17
- Operating expenses increased by 14.1 percent compared to Q2'17
- General growth in pay rate 1.7 percent y-o-y
- Other operating expenses increased 24.0 percent


EBIT and EBIT margin

EBIT and EBIT margin (LTM)




Cash flow

- Cash flow from operations
 - NOK 31.8 million in Q2'18 compared to NOK 6.2 million in Q2'17
- Last 12 months
 - Operational cash flow over the last 12 months was NOK 173.3 million
- Cash flow from investing activities
 - Negative NOK 16.0 million compared to negative NOK 6.5 million in Q2'17
