




Customer and project mix

Variably priced contracts share of revenues Percentage




10 largest customers share of revenues Percentage







Revenue

- Revenues increased by 16.6 percent y-o-y
 - Revenues from own consultants increased by 18.5 percent to NOK 392.6 million
 - Revenues from sub-contracted consultants increased by 10.1 percent to NOK 55.9 million
 - Other revenues decreased by 7.1 percent to NOK 12.3 million

Revenue split (quarterly figures)




Revenue split (12 months rolling average) MNOK




Revenues from own consultants

- Increased 18.5 percent y-o-y
 - Positive impact from 14 percent increase in average number of employees
 - Positive impact from 4.6 percent increase in prices for group hourly services
 - Negative impact from decrease in billing ratio by 2.3 percentage points
 - 66 workdays in Q3'19 one more than Q3'18


Revenue per employee (quarterly figures)

Earnings

- Operating profit (EBIT) increased by 61.9 percent to NOK 32.6 million
- EBIT margin of 7.1 percent compared to 5.1 percent in Q3'18
- Operating expenses increased by 14.1 percent y-o-y
- General growth in pay rate 2.5 percent y-o-y

MNOK and Percent




EBIT and EBIT margin (LTM)


Change in revenues – effect on EBIT




Cash flow

- Cash flow from operations
 - NOK 10.8 million in Q3'19 compared to NOK -14.1 million in Q3'18
- Last 12 months
 - Operational cash flow over the last 12 months was NOK 263.2 million
- Cash flow from investing activities
 - Negative NOK 6.6 million compared to negative NOK 10.1 million in Q3'18
